ARTS San Antonio, the arts nonprofit organization responsible for bringing the Shaolin Warriors and Anthony Bourdain late last year, holds a two-night fundraiser this week.

The Floating Festival provides participants a multi-course dinner at five points along the River Walk on Wednesday and Thursday.

A reception both nights will be held at the Convention Center — the launch and docking point. The Festival then hits Zocca on the River Walk (caprese salad), Boudro's Texas Bistro (tuna tartar tostados), Acenar (jicama shrimp tacos) and Biga on the Banks (braised lamb lasagna). Coffee and dessert will await folks at the Convention Center.

Tickets, \$175 for individuals, are available at artssa.org, or by calling (210) 226-2891. Parking is available at the Grand Hyatt. Reception begins in Room 006 Wednesday, Room 004 Thursday.

In its 20th year, ARTS San Antonio puts on a full performing arts season each year, and touches the community through arts education workshops for elementary school kids.
